<p>PROCESS BOILER Requirements :</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> ✓ Available to industrial end-use customers who manufacture a sellable product only (NAICS codes 31-33) ✓ Boilers must meet a minimum combustion efficiency of 82% as installed ✓ Only process boilers qualify ✓ The manufacturer name and equipment model number must be provided ✓ A flue gas analysis measured under full load conditions is required to document combustion efficiency after install is complete <p>SPACE HEATING BOILER Requirements:</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> ✓ Boilers must meet efficiency requirements based on size and type ✓ Include a manufacturer's specification sheet documenting these characteristics ✓ Boiler must be used for space heating for human comfort as defined by California Titles 20 & 24 standards <p>COMMERCIAL BOILER Requirements:</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> ✓ Only boilers > 75,000 Btuh qualify ✓ For non-industrial, non-process and non space heating applications ✓ Equipment used for pools and spas does not qualify ✓ Include a manufacturer's specification sheet documenting these characteristics <p>Permits required in compliance with local regulations for Customer or Contractor Incentives.
