Silver

Standard 180 (Table 5.20) compliant inspection and maintenance (excluding combustion analysis)

- Optimize refrigerant charge
- Clean condenser coil
- Check, clean and/or replace filter
- Upgrade valve caps to brass with O-ring seal
- Check and adjust airflow
- Inspect and adjust unit for proper operation
- Lubricate serviceable bearings
- Clean evaporator coil (if needed)
- Replace damaged refrigerant line insulation
- Inspect and comb bent condenser fan fins
- Check and restore economizer operation
- Increase duct insulation in pre-1992 buildings (limited to exposed ducts in unconditioned space) with customer co-payment.



Gold

With purchase of 1-year maintenance agreement addendum, committing to renew for a 3-year term. Enrolled units qualify for ACCA-180 QM and preventative maintenance incentives (excluding combustion analysis)

- Coil cleaning (condenser and evaporator coils)
- Fan maintenance
- Refrigerant system test
- Refrigerant system service

Platinum

All services offered in the Gold Tune-up plus an additional \$50 per enrolled unit to cover services and repairs not covered above. The Platinum Tune-up requires the purchase of a three-year (or one-year with automatic three-year renewal) maintenance agreement AND customer co-payment of \$100 per unit for additional services and repairs such as refrigerant evacuation to correct restrictions or noncondensables, compressor replacement, belt replacement, ductwork and other repairs necessary to improve the performance of the units enrolled. The \$50 incentive can be applied toward the major repair of a single enrolled unit or spread across repairs multiple units. Incentives require documentation of repairs performed and access for verification activities. Customer incentives up to \$3,836 per eligible unit available for quality maintenance service agreement. (Incentives paid over three years with proof of continuing eligibility and maintenance.)
